### DOUGNGOUZAWA, NIGER

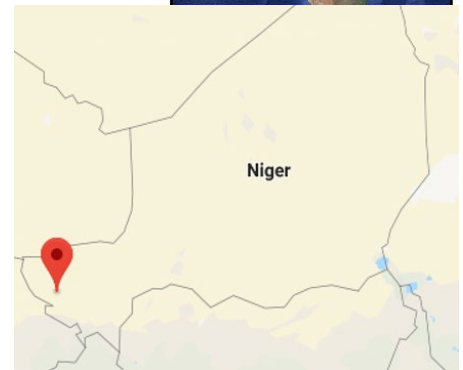
Thanks to your donation, members of Doungouzawa are now accessing clean water and enjoying the prospect of a healthier future. This new water point is providing safe water to 962 people.

Committees comprised of women and men from the community have been trained to manage the water point and ensure the availability of water for generations. Our integrated community engagement model focuses on empowerment and sustainability in order to ensure a continuous supply of safe water.

Through our partnership with World Vision, we are multiplying the health benefits of clean water by also addressing sanitation and hygiene in Doungouzawa.

Intervention activities include helping people build and maintain latrines, promoting handwashing and the use of soap, and eliminating open defecation. The combination of safe water, sanitation, and hygiene intervention reduces childhood disease and death by more than half. The addition of this water point will also increase access to education for girls and reduce gender disparities in the community.
