Girls are not able to go to school and women have no time to work productively to generate income for their families. This doesn’t have to happen. Drill a well deep into the ground and lives are transformed instantly: child mortality is reduced by 65%, girls go to school, and women get micro-loans and start small businesses, feeling pride in their accomplishment. They have hope for their future. Wells Bring Hope is a tax exempt 501(c)(3) organization.
